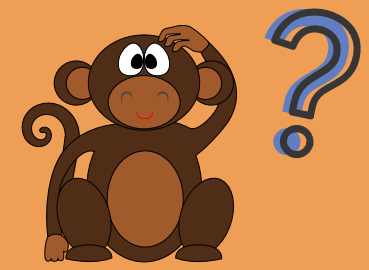


SENTIENTIST



no harm to nonhuman

merely instrumental value



analogous to speciesism



SENTIENTISM



unjustified preference to
one's own "kind"

We have a moral obligation to preserve some natural habitat that is of no
value to human beings if its destruction would harm some nonhuman animals
